PROJECT UPDATE 01

Concrete Skateparks have been awarded the tender to construct the Mackay District Skate and Wheeled Sports Plaza. This facility will be the region's first district level state of the art skate park facility. The family friendly skate park will include 1500sqm of mix discipline skate and wheeled sports rideable features, as well as 600sqm of recreational area.

Features of the new park will include:

- Competition Bowl
- Intermediate (Mini) Bowl
- Street Circuit
- Parkour Area
- Multipurpose Court
- Climbing and Hit Up Walls
- Terrace and Spectator Areas
- Stage for Events
- Picnic Facilities

- Amenities
- Landscaping

The park is located at 33 Norris Road Park Access, North Mackay, adjacent to the Mackay PCYC.

The \$2.2 million project is jointly funded between the Commonwealth Government and Mackay Regional Council.
