Overview

The park is located at 33 Norris Road Park Access, North Mackay. The site is adjacent to the Mackay PCYC. The project is jointly funded between the Australian Government and Mackay Regional Council. Council has added carpark works and additional facilities to the scope bringing the total budget to \$2.5 million.

With the Sugar Bowl Mackay due to be open by the end of the month, the skate park is nearing completion. The competition bowl is being poured and it's quite intimidating standing at the top looking down in to the bowl, it certainly won't be for the faint hearted.

Landscape work is well underway & breaks up the concrete areas nicely giving the area a very pleasant ambiance. Signage and graphics has been completed and really makes for a vibrant modern look to the facility. The upgraded carpark is complete, allowing plenty of additional parking for the site.
