Purpose of the Policy

The purpose of the Community Safety Design Policy is to provide guidance to applicants when making a development application for a material change of use involving "*vulnerable premises*" as defined in the Environment and Infrastructure Code.

This policy does not apply to self assessable development.

Vulnerable Premises - Supporting Information

- (1) Council may request further details to accompany a development application for "*vulnerable premises*", focussing on the design of the streetscape and areas around the premises to be used by the public. The details should include:
 - (a) a risk assessment and safety audit;
 - (b) security strategies for vulnerable people;
 - (c) street furniture and movement spaces appropriate to the size and use of the centre;
 - (d) footpath activities such as cafes and seating external to the development;
 - (e) clear signposting of the location of public facilities including telephones, baby change facilities, public toilets available to the public in public and private establishments; and
 - (f) the location of activities and movement routes to promote casual surveillance.
