

OBJECTION TO STATE GOVERNMENT EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT LEVY

Mackay Regional Council, as a Local Government Authority, is obliged to collect the State Government Emergency Management Levy under the Fire and Emergency Service Act 1990.

Where a property owner disagrees with the charge included on the rate notice (whether that be due to the amount or the Levy Category the property was assigned to), they have the right to appeal to the Commissioner Queensland Fire and Rescue Service.

Prior to an appeal being lodged with the Commissioner Queensland Fire and Rescue Service, the property owner is required to contact the Local Council and have them:

- consider the circumstances of the case that the property owner advises
- · correct any identified error

Where the Property Owner is dissatisfied with the outcome of Council's review, they may lodge an appeal.

<u>Please note that the appeal must be lodged to the Commissioner Queensland Fire and Rescue Service within thirty days from the issue date of the rate notice.</u>
