

Snake Vine

Hibbertia scandens
hee-BERT-ee-ah SCAN-dens



A vigorous, versatile climbing plant, or ground cover without support, with intense blooms of golden-yellow flowers during spring and summer.

Individual flowers only last one or two days but are replaced over a long period. Tolerates coastal conditions.

Makes an excellent screening plant on walls or fences. Makes a superb trailing plant for a garden or hanging pot if watered regularly.
