

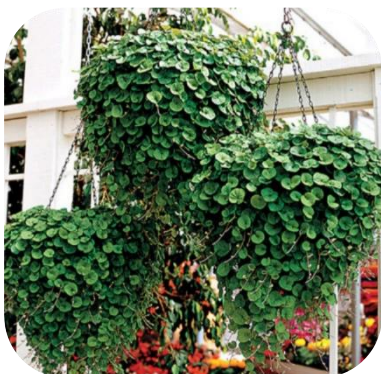
# Kidney Weed

*Dichondra repens*  
di-KON-druh REE-penz



**A fast-growing creeping plant that spreads widely from underground stolons, making it a good ground cover. The soft, low foliage makes for a great no-mow lawn alternative in low traffic areas.**

It grows best in moist, lightly shaded areas but will grow in sunny spots provided it gets water in drier times. Ideal for under trees, or other areas where it may be difficult to establish grass, particularly in shaded areas. One of the most popular uses is planting between pavers, or garden steps and along pathways as it does not require much maintenance.
