**A delightful spreading herb with succulent and slightly hairy leaves. Tiny white flowers on spikes up to 12cm long. The flowers are barely visible and look more like plain green spikes on the end of the branches. Very hardy indoor plant.**

Likes to grow on mossy rocks, tree trunks, and other various shady spots. Great spreading and hardy ground cover.

**HOT TIP:** Feed conservatively, once a month with a liquid fertiliser or when needed.
