

Election signs



Election signs are subject to the following criteria:

- an election sign is only permissible on land that is not public land
- an election sign may only be displayed during an election period
- each election sign must be removed within seven days of the polling day for the election.

The sign must:

- not cause a nuisance
- be kept and maintained at all times in good order and condition and free of graffiti
- be structurally sound
- not cause obstruction of, or distraction to, pedestrian or vehicular traffic.

FAQs

Can I place my election sign on a road side?

No.

Election signage must only be placed on rateable land.

Can I have an election sign on my vehicle or trailer?

Yes.

The sign must not have a face area more than 6m² and must not cause a hazard to pedestrian or vehicular traffic. The vehicle/trailer must only be parked on rateable land.

What will happen if my sign is placed on council land or road reserve?

Signage on council land or road reserve may be impounded and penalties may apply.
