Crinum pedunculatum

KRIN-um ped-un-kew-LAH-tum

Height: up to 2 metres

Spread: up to 3 metres



Part shade



Tolerates boggy and dry conditions



Tolerates a range of soils



Host to the Lily Caterpillar moth



Traditional use plant

A clumping plant with bright green upright foliage and white 'spider' flowers.

Commonly found along riverbanks, beachfronts, mangroves fringes and swampy areas this plant can tolerate a wide range of conditions.

It makes an excellent feature plant for a home garden.
