

Native Frangipani

Hymenosporum flavum
hy-men-OS-por-um FLAY-vum



Category: Tree (5-10m)

Height: 10 metres

Spread: 3 metres



Full sun to part shade



Prefers moisture



Rich fertile well-drained soil



Bee attracting



Great for large pots

Native Frangipani is one of the most popular Australian native trees. Its narrow growth habit makes it popular for urban gardens.

Deep glossy evergreen leaves, cream flowers (that can have a red-tinged centre) fade to dark yellow with age and have a lovely sweet scent. What more could you want in a tree?

Use as a shade tree, make a feature in a large pot or plant as a screen. Screen plantings can be pruned after flowering to encourage bushy growth.
