Sterculia quadrifida

A hardy deciduous tree with spreading canopy and eye-catching red boat-shaped fruits and black seeds.

Some leaves are dropped in winter, and in cooler climates, this plant may be deciduous. An excellent feature plant for a home garden. The edible seeds taste somewhat like peanuts.
