Overview

The park is located at 33 Norris Road Park Access, North Mackay. The site is adjacent to the Mackay PCYC. The project is jointly funded between the Australian Government and Mackay Regional Council. Council has added carpark works and additional facilities to the scope bringing the total budget to \$2.5 million.

Features of the new park will include:

- Carparking area

Progress

Progress at the skate park continues, impressive looking shade structures are under construction, also parkour and other recreational elements are being installed. The intermediate and street circuit bowls are now poured. The park's unique feature, a skateable D11 carry blade has been installed. Landscaping works have commenced. Council is conducting an upgrade to the parking area at the PCYC to compliment the skate facility. Graphic designs have been completed ready for artwork to commence. The combination of the planned artwork and the brightly coloured yellow accents on skating & parkour elements will really make the park 'pop' and make for a vibrant area for all to enjoy.
