

# Silky Wattle

*Acacia holosericea*

uh-KAY-shuh hoh-loh-ser-ee-KEE-uh

Category: Shrub (under 5m)

Height: 4 metre

Spread: 3 metre



Full sun



Drought tolerant once established



Well-drained soil



Suitable for hedging or Screening



This is a food tree for the larvae of Northern Imperial Blue butterfly



Traditional use plant

**A fast growing Wattle that, like all Acacias, has the ability to fix the atmospheric nitrogen levels in poor soils. This shrub is recommended for its foliage and can be used as a feature plant, screen or hedging plant.**

The soft leaves of this Acacia can be used as bush soap, producing a soapy foam when rubbed in water.

**HOT TIP: Prune regularly to maintain rounded shape**
