

Creek Cherry

Syzygium australe

Height: 3 to 6 metres

Spread: 2 to 3 metres

Suitable for hedging



Full sun to part shade



Drought tolerant once established

This fast-growing evergreen native is a popular choice for shade trees and hedges. Glossy green foliage starts off a beautiful bronze colour.

White powder-puff like flowers are followed in Summer by edible pink berries that have a crisp apple like texture and mild sweetness.

Suitable for hedging and screens. Prune from a young age to encourage thick dense growth. Suitable for pots.
