Archontophoenix alexandrae

ar-kon-toh-FEE-niks al-ecks-AN-dray

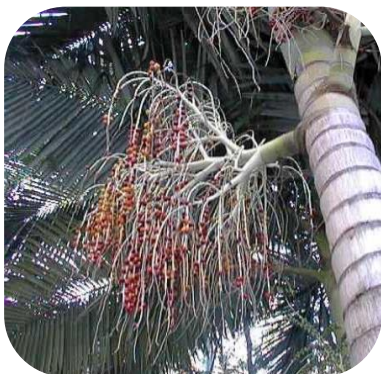


A tall, single-stemmed palm tree that is found naturally in rainforests and riverine areas. Large sprays of small cream flowers, followed by small, red, globular fruit.

Has a classic "palm" look and is fast growing - making it a perfect palm for subtropical gardeners wanting to establish a native tropical garden in a hurry.

Underplant with native gingers and ferns for a lush leafy effect. A larval food plant for many butterflies.

Birds and flying foxes eat the fruit.
