

Alexandra Palm

Archontophoenix alexandrae
Ar-kon-to-FEE-nix al-ex-AN-dray

Height: up to 30 metres

Spread: 2 to 3 metres



A tall, single-stemmed palm tree.

Found naturally in rainforests and riverine areas. Large sprays of small cream flowers, followed by small, red, globular fruit.

A larval food plant for many butterflies. Birds and flying foxes eat the fruit.
