

# Common Rush

*Juncus usitatus*

JUN-kus ewe-see-TAR-tus



**An upright sedge with a tussock habit that makes a good accent plant. It has green cylindrical foliage, with tones of copper during winter.**

Juncus is a versatile sedge that is ideal for dry creek bed landscape features, narrow garden beds, planter boxes and water features.

The clumping cylindrical foliage stabilises banks and can be easily divided and replanted when needed. Juncus provides great habitat for frogs and birds.
