

Common Rush

Juncus usitatus

JUN-kus ewe-see-TAR-tus

Height: up to 1.2 metres

Spread: up to 1.5 metres



Full sun to part shade



Dry to damp areas



Adaptable to a wide range of soils



Provides habitat

An upright sedge with a tussock habit that makes a good accent plant. It has green cylindrical foliage, with tones of copper during winter. Juncus is a versatile sedge that is ideal for dry creek bed landscape features, narrow garden beds, planter boxes and water features.

The clumping cylindrical foliage stabilises banks and can be easily divided and replanted when needed. Juncus provides habitat for frogs and birds.
