

Australian Bugle

Ajuga australis

a-JOOG-a os-TRA-liss



A herbaceous, perennial plant producing a basal rosette of velvety toothed leaves and soft erect flowering stems of up to 30cm high with flowers that are usually a deep blue or purple.

This plant is widely used by native bees, with the flowers being slightly scented. It is a tough little plant that can grow well in most positions if the soil is well drained.

Height: 0.2 metre

Part to full shade
