

# Java Sedge

*Cyperus javanicus*

sy-PER-rus jar-van-EE-kuss



**This hardy tufted perennial sedge has grey-green foliage which provides great contrast in a garden.**

Naturally found growing in seasonally wet depressions, this plant makes a fabulous, tufted border or filler plant. Java Sedge tolerates drier conditions although performs better in a damp location. Looks brilliant planted en masse.
