Interestingly scented foliage and lovely white flowers that attracts insects and a great source of pollen for bees.

This paperbark doesn't mind moist areas and is adaptable to a range of soil types. Great to use as a screening tree and is normally found alongside riverbeds and water courses where it can be susceptible to extreme conditions like drought and flooding.

HOT TIP: Prune when young to create a dense shrub or hedge
