This hardy, prostrate groundcover brings colour to even the harshest of localities.

Naturally growing on coastal rockfaces, sand dunes or in woodlands, this plant can tolerate salty winds and minimal water.

The green foliage is rough to the touch. A yellow daisy-type flower is produced in the warmer months. Remove spent flowers to keep this plant looking fresh.
