DIRECT DEBIT REQUEST SERVICE AGREEMENT

This is *your* Direct Debit Service *Agreement* with Mackay Regional Council, User ID 121948, ABN 56 240 712 069. It explains what *your* obligations are when undertaking a Direct Debit arrangement with *us*. It also details what our obligations are to *you* as *your* Direct Debit provider. **Please keep this** *agreement* **for future reference.** It forms part of the terms and conditions of *your Direct Debit Request (DDR)* and should be read in conjunction with *your DDR* authorisation.

Definitions	account means the account held at your financial institution from which we are authorised to arrange for funds to be debited.					
	agreement means this Direct Debit Request Service Agreement between you and us.					
	banking day means a day other than a Saturday or a Sunday or a public holiday listed throughout Australia. debit day means the day that payment by you to us is due. debit payment means a particular transaction where a debit is made. direct debit request or DDR means the Direct Debit Request between us and you. us or we or Council means Mackay Regional Council (the Debit User) you have authorised by requesting a					
	Direct Debit Request.					
	you means the customer who has signed or authorised by other means the Direct Debit Request.					
	your financial institution means the financial institution nominated by you on the DDR at which the account is maintained.					
1. Debiting your account	1.1 By signing a <i>Direct Debit Request</i> or by providing <i>us</i> with a valid instruction, <i>you</i> have authorised <i>us</i> to arrange for funds to be debited from <i>your account</i> . <i>You</i> should refer to the <i>Direct Debit Request</i> and this <i>agreement</i> for the terms of the arrangement between <i>us</i> and <i>you</i> .					
	1.2 We will only arrange for funds to be debited from your account as authorised in the Direct Debit Request or					
	We will only arrange for funds to be debited from your account if we have sent to the address nominated by you in the DDR or on Council's records, a billing advice which specifies the amount payable by you to us and when it is due.					
	1.3 If the debit day falls on a day that is not a banking day, we may direct your financial institution to debit your account on the following banking day. If you are unsure about which day your account has or will be debited you should ask your financial institution.					
2. Amendment by us	2.1 We may vary any details of this <i>agreement</i> or a <i>Direct Debit Request</i> at any time by giving <i>you</i> at least fourteen (14) days written notice.					
3. Amendments by you	3.1 You may terminate this agreement by providing us with at least fourteen (14) days notification by writing to: The CEO

	arranging it through <i>your</i> own <i>financial institution</i> , which is required to act promptly on <i>your</i> instructions.					
	3.2 Due to administrative and technology restraints, Council cannot suspend, defer or stop an individual debit payment. Council requires that the Direct Debit Request be cancelled and a new					
	direct debit arrangement be entered into by completing a new <i>DDR</i> form or by phoning <i>Council</i> .					
	3.3 Council requires that the Direct Debit Request be cancelled and a new direct debit arrangement be entered into by completing a new DDR form or by phoning Council, if any of the following changes* are required by you:					
	a) A change to <i>your account</i> details (i.e. changes to <i>financial institution</i> and/or branch,					
	account name, account and/or BSB numbers)					
	b) A change to the payment amount, <i>debit day</i> or frequency of payments.					
	*Note: in relation to the above reference to 'change', your financial institution may 'change' your debit payment only to the extent of advising us, of your new account details.

4.	Your obligations	4.1	It is your responsibility to ensure that there are sufficient clear funds available in your account to allow a debit payment to be made in accordance with the Direct Debit Request.
		4.2	If there are insufficient clear funds in your account to meet the debit payment:
			a) You may be charged a fee and/or interest by your financial institution
			b) You may also incur fees or charges imposed or incurred by us; and
			c) You may be required to arrange for the debit payment to be made by another
			method or arrange for sufficient clear funds to be in <i>your account</i> by an agreed time
		4.3	so that we can process the <i>debit payment</i> .
		4.3	You should check your account statement to verify that the amounts debited from your account are correct.
		4.4	Ensure that your direct debit agreement is cancelled upon sale of your property. Any funds
			credited to your rates assessment after a change of ownership has been registered with Council,
			may not be refunded or transferred to a new rates assessment.
5. Di	Dispute	5.1	If you believe that there has been an error in debiting your account, you should notify us directly on telephone number 1300 622 529 and confirm that notice in writing with us as soon as possible so that we can resolve your query more quickly. Alternatively you can take it up directly with your financial institution.
		5.2	If we conclude as a result of our investigations that your account has been incorrectly debited
		3.2	we will respond to your query by arranging for your financial institution to adjust your account
			(including interest and charges) accordingly. We will also notify <i>you</i> in writing of the amount by
			which your account has been adjusted. However any amount credited to your assessment with
			Council will also be reversed.
		5.3	If we conclude as a result of our investigations that your account has not been incorrectly
			debited we will respond to your query by providing you with reasons and any evidence for this finding in writing.
6. Accounts	Accounts	6.1	You should check:
			a) With your financial institution whether direct debiting is available from your account
			as direct debiting is not available on all <i>accounts</i> offered by <i>financial institutions</i> . b) Your account details which you have provided to us are correct by checking them
			against a recent account statement; and
			c) With your financial institution before completing the Direct Debit Request if you have
			any queries about how to complete the DDR.
		6.2	You should advise Council if your account is transferred or closed (five working days notice is
			required).
7.	Confidentiality	7.1	We will keep any information (including your account details) in your Direct Debit Request
			confidential. We will make reasonable efforts to keep any such information that we have about
			you secure and to ensure that any of our employees or agents who have access to information about you do not make any unauthorised use, modification, reproduction or disclosure of that
			information.
		7.2	We will only disclose information that we have about you:
			a) To the extent specifically required by law; or
			b) For the purpose of this <i>agreement</i> (including disclosing information in connection
			with any query or claim).

		8.2	We will notify <i>you</i> by sending a notice in the ordinary post or by email, to your nominated email
			/ postal address on <i>Council's</i> records.
		8.3	Any notice will be deemed to have been received on the third banking day after posting.
9.	Enquiries	9.1	Direct all enquiries to Mackay Regional Council in the first instance, or you may contact your
			financial institution. Enquiries should be made at least five (5) working days prior to the next
			scheduled <i>debit day</i> . All communication addressed to <i>Council</i> should include <i>your</i> rates
			assessment number.
