

Native Gardenia

Atractocarpus fitzalanii subsp. fitzalanii
at-rak-toe-KAR-puss fitz-AL-an-ee-eye



A large shrub or small tree with lush glossy leaves, perfumed white star-shaped flowers and large yellow fruit.

This plant prefers a moist well drained soil. An established plant can tolerate both full sun and part shade. An excellent feature plant for a home garden which can be kept in a pot or pruned into a hedge.

Height: up to 6 metres

Spread: 1.5 metres
