Category: Ground cover/low growing under 1m

Height: 0.1-0.6 metres

Drought tolerant once established



Prefers a well-drained sandy soil

A dainty herb with prolific yellow to gold, small, button-head flowers and silver foliage.

This plant is adaptable to most growing conditions but does exceptionally well in rockeries, garden beds and pots. Mass plant for effect. Makes a good addition to your borders especially if you are trying to achieve a 'cottage garden' look and need something colourful to fill foreground space. Removing spent flower heads keeps this plant looking neat and tidy.

HOT TIP:

Plant in a sunny spot for compact growth and lots of flowers.
