

# Cook's Screw Pine

*Pandanus cookii*  
pan-DAN-us COOK-ee-eye



**This palm-like tree with spiralling grey/green foliage and prop roots makes for an interesting feature in any garden.**

Orange pineapple-like fruit hanging from branches make for a conversation starter. Leaf margins are typically smooth although small teeth may be present on juvenile foliage and leaf undersides. Commonly found near swamps and creeks, this plant can handle wetter soils.



Category: Tree (5-10m)

Height: 6 - 10 metres

Spread: 2 - 8 metres



Full sun to part shade



Prefers adequate moisture but drought tolerant once established



Prefers well drained soils but is hardy under most conditions
