

# Native Pomegranate

*Capparis arborea*

KAP-ah-riss ah-BORE-ee-uh



A slow starter, this hardy evergreen tree is drought tolerant. Spectacular fist-sized, lightly-scented white flowers that open at night, are followed by round edible fruit with a sweet, tasty pulp.

Retain only one main trunk for use as a tree, or tip prune regularly from a young age for a shrub.
