Beach Sunflower is a coastal sprawling perennial herb or climbing shrub which can grow up to 1 metre tall.

A scrambling ground daisy which would look very nice in any garden. Yellow daisy heads about 2 cm across and ovate leaves 10 cm long. Grows naturally in coastal areas in sandy soils near the beach. Needs a well-drained soil and full sun position to do well.

This plant's flowers are very attractive to insects.

HOT TIP: Can be cut back after flowering to keep compact or allowed to spread and cover the ground.
