

Orange Bark

Denhamia disperma

den-hay-ME-uh dy-SPUR-muh

Height: up to 6 metres

Spread: up to 8 metres



A small fast-growing dry rainforest tree suitable for suburban gardens. It has a tidy neat form with a rounded dense crown.

Small white flowers are produced between August and December followed by bright yellow capsules that spilt to reveal one or two red-brown seeds. The bark is highly decorative with horizontal markings. The dense leaves provide shelter and nesting sites for birds. Can be pruned to shape if desired.
