

Bower of Beauty

Pandorea jasminoides

Pan-DOOR-ee-uh jazz-min-OY-deez

Height: up to 4.5 metres

Spread: 2 to 3 metres



Full sun to part shade



Drought tolerant once established



Well drained soil



Butterfly attracting



Bird attracting

This glossy evergreen climber produces masses of long-lasting pink or white trumpet shaped flowers through summer and autumn.

Let this beauty ramble over an arbour or trellis. It's great for hiding unsightly fences or paintwork. Alternatively, they can be used as a dense, bird-sheltering groundcover, in an open situation where they won't find anything to climb on.

Pandorea develop strong penetrating root systems and should not be planted near underground pipelines.
