Perfect for Pots

This species produces bright red berries, slightly larger in size and milder in taste than the more commonly known raspberries.

We recommend growing Atherton Raspberry in a large pot, due to its aggressive vigour. Left unchecked, it's not uncommon for a healthy specimen to take over an entire garden bed. It's the perfect little fruiter for a patio or balcony garden and can also be trellis trained.

HOT TIP: The secret to taste is timing — these berries may turn red long before they're truly ripe. Wait until the fruit practically falls off its stem when touched.
