Traditional use plant

**A large attractive shrub or small tree with lush glossy leaves, perfumed white star-shaped flowers and large yellow fruit.**

This plant prefers moist well-drained soils. An established plant can tolerate both full sun and part shade. An excellent feature plant for a home garden which can be kept in a pot or pruned into a hedge.

## HOT TIP:

Similar to a mangosteen in size, shape and flavour, the fruit may be enjoyed raw on their own or used in salads, tarts, cakes and other desserts.
