A large shrub or small tree with beautifully scented white star-shaped flowers and lush glossy leaves and yellow round fruit has seen this plant enter cultivation in subtropical gardens.

This plant prefers a moist well drained soil but can be tolerable of poor drainage. An established plant can tolerate both full sun and part shade.

An excellent feature plant for a home garden which can be kept in a pot or pruned into a hedge.

HOT TIP: Fruit is similar to a mangosteen in size, shape and flavour.
