

Blue Flax Lily

Dianella caerulea

dy-an-ELL-uh key-ROO-lee-uh



A hardy and easy-care perennial with strappy green foliage. Sprays of blue flowers emerge during warmer months followed by edible blue berries.

Growing from a rhizome which can be divided and replanted, this plant works well planted as a thick border, fills in gaps and looks brilliant planted en masse. This local plant is one of the prettiest and easiest plants for your garden.
