Part Shade - Full Sun



Water regularly

An attractive shrub with bright scarlet flowers occurring in spring through to summer. Leaves resemble a holly shaped.

Fairly quick growing in warmer climates and can tolerate full-sun if watered regularly. Ideal as a screening plant and is ideal for pots. Attracts birds while fruiting.

HOT TIP: Listed as vulnerable in the wild.
