

# Spiny-headed Mat-rush

*Lomandra longifolia*

loh-MAN-druh long-gee-FOH-lee-uh



**This super-hardy clumping strappy grass, with grey/green foliage, makes a great border or feature plant. In nature, Lomandras protect creek banks from erosion.**

Soil moisture is required for growth although the plant will survive without supplementary watering. During times of drought foliage curls tightly inwards. This Mat-rush can handle wet spells but not prolonged waterlogging.
