

Spiny-headed Mat-rush

Lomandra longifolia

loh-MAN-druh long-ee-FOH-lee-uh



This super hardy clumping strappy grass, with grey/green foliage, makes a great border plant or feature. In nature Lomandras protect creek banks from erosion.

Soil moisture is required for growth although the plant will survive without supplementary watering. During times of drought foliage curls tightly inwards. This Mat-rush can handle wet spells as long as it's not prolonged.

Plants can be cut back hard to encourage fresh growth.

Height: 0.4 to 1 metre

Spread: 0.4 to 0.6 metres
