

Eungella Coleus

Eungella coleus is an intriguing, rare plant naturally found on granite outcrops above 700m altitude in the Eungella region.

This erect or straggling sub shrub has foliage covered densely with hairs. Upright sprays of small purple flowers are produced throughout the year attracting many different pollinators.

This versatile plant can be trimmed to shape, suits a cottage-style garden, and performs well in pots.

HOT TIP: Pruning after flowering will encourage a dense growth habit.
