1 Purpose of this Information Bulletin

To provide clear and concise instructions relating to asphaltic pavement thickness where using AC10M.

2 Details

Council's Standard Drawings A3-3618 Local Street Cross Section Access Place Urban and A3-3617 Local Street Cross Section Access Street Urban prescribes a minimum 30mm of asphalt pavement where using AC10M.

Planning Scheme Policy – Pavement Design v1.1 took effect on 1 March 2021. As part of this amendment, s5.4 Asphaltic concrete prescribes that for asphalt pavement thickness <u>up to</u> 35mm, AC10M must be used. This applies to the construction of Access Place and Access Street roads.

Interpretation of Council's Standard Drawings and Planning Scheme Policy – Pavement Design v1.1, has been raised with a request sought for clarification on Council's position as to whether the minimum asphalt pavement thickness is 30mm or 35mm where using AC10M.

3 Position Statement

Where using AC10M, a minimum asphalt pavement thickness of 30mm is acceptable. This applies to the construction of Access Place and Access Streets across the Mackay Region.
