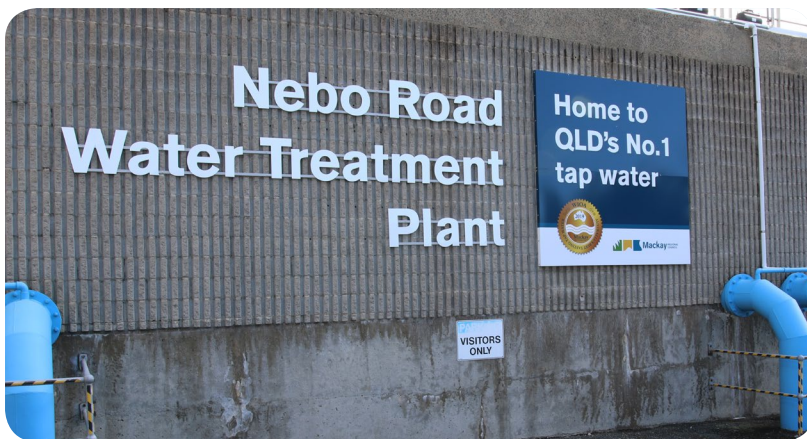


Nebo Road Water Treatment Plant

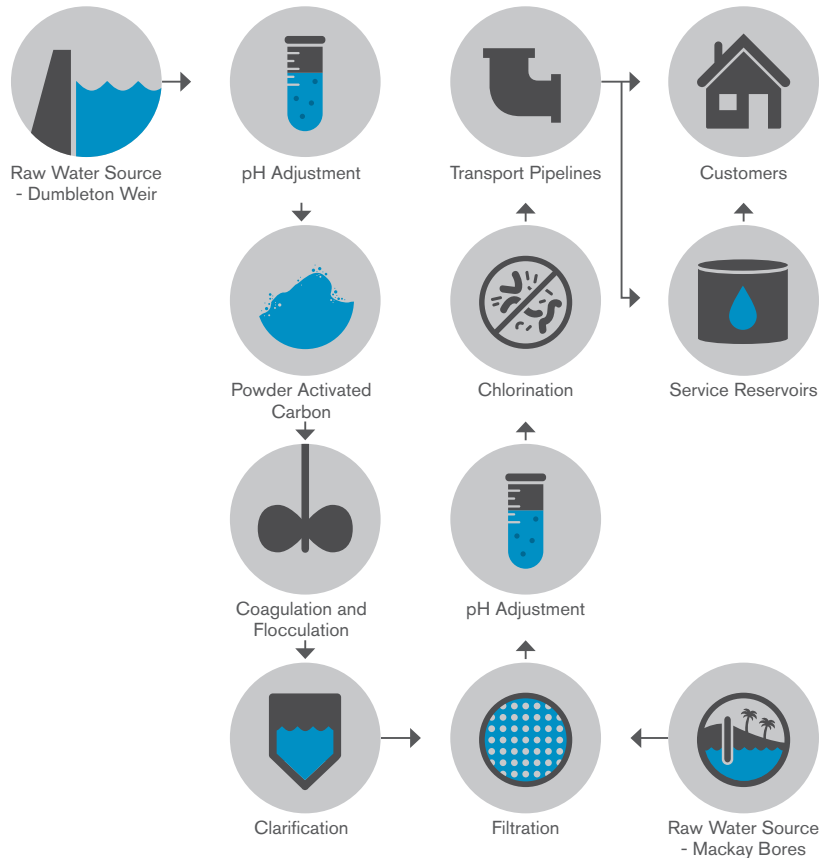


The Nebo Road Water Treatment Plant (WTP) is located approximately three kilometres to the south-west of the Mackay CBD on land adjoining the Mackay Regional Botanic Gardens.

It is council's largest water treatment plant. The water treatment plant has the design capacity to treat 75 ML of water per day.

The plant treats raw water sourced from the Dumbleton Weir on the Pioneer River and water from groundwater bores located in close proximity to the plant.

Water from the Nebo Road Water Treatment Plant supplies the Mackay and Sarina water supply schemes.
