



How the 10-cent refund works



Collect your eligible containers



ELIGIBLE CONTAINERS



INELIGIBLE CONTAINERS



Most glass, plastic, aluminium, steel and paper-based cartons between 150mL and 3L.



Containers not commonly found in litter, including all plain milk, flavoured milks 1L and above, pure juice drinks, wine and spirit bottles, cordials.

Once you have collected your eligible containers you can take them into your Mackay/Paget Depot to be paid the refund amount on the spot, via electronic funds transfer or you may choose to have the refund donated to your local community group

OR

You can use our convenient bin change over service



Drop your identified bag into your nearest Community Drop and Go Bin (with your Scheme Id# inside your bag). We will collect your bag on our schedule pick up. After your bag is collected and counted, your refund will be paid by electronic fund transfer into your nominated bank account, or you may choose to have the refund donated to your local community group.

When returning eligible containers, they must be empty and free from contamination. We do have the right as an authorised container refund point operator to refuse to accept ineligible containers, including those that are contaminated.

Crushed or squashed containers can be accepted at most refund points as long as the container is recognisable as an eligible container. The containers should be returned with the caps removed. Glass bottles must be kept whole.

How will I receive the refund amount?

You may be paid the refund amount at a container refund point in one of the following ways:

- **Cash** – this is only available at our Mackay/Paget depot and only up to the limit of \$80
The payment of the refund in cash is at the discretion of the refund point operator.
- **Direct deposit to your bank account**, via your scheme account.

If you take our containers to a donation point (local school, club etc), or choose 'donate' as an option, your 10 cents will be donated to the charity, school or organisation of your choice.
