Mackay Regional Council Citizen of the Year

» **Aged 26 years and over as of January 26, 2022.**

Recognises outstanding members of the community for their personal endeavours, achievements and community input.

Consider the following criteria when nominating:

- How has the nominee made an outstanding contribution to the local community?
- What are the achievements of the nominee?
- How is the nominee an inspirational role model for the community?
- What sacrifice or challenges has the nominee experienced in their endeavours?
- Has the nominee left a legacy to the community?

Mackay Regional Council Young Citizen of the Year

» **Aged 16-25 years as of January 26, 2022.**

Recognises young citizens for their personal endeavours, achievements and community input. Consider the following criteria when nominating:

- How has the nominee made an outstanding contribution to the local community?
- What are the achievements of the nominee?
- How is the nominee an inspirational role model for the community?
- What sacrifices or challenges has the nominee experienced in their endeavours?

General conditions of entry:

1. Nominees must be a resident of Mackay Regional Council at the time of the nomination.
2. Nominations will not be accepted if the individual or group has won an award the previous year.
3. All nominations must be received on the official nomination form. Additional information can be supplied.
4. Contact details of nominators may be forwarded on to local media.
5. Citizen of the Year nominees must be over 26 years of age as at January 26, 2022.
6. Young Citizen of the Year nominees must be aged 16-25 years as at January 26, 2022.

Arts and Culture Award

Recognises individuals or groups involved in the region's rich cultural and arts community.

Community Group Award

Recognises an organisation, group or sporting association for its outstanding contribution and dedication towards improving, promoting and/or protecting the lives of residents in the Mackay Regional Council area.

Environmental Achievement Award

Recognises individuals or groups who demonstrate a genuine passion for the environment and strive to improve it through conservation, preservation, protection and education.

Lori Burgess Community Volunteer Award

Recognises an individual who has worked tirelessly for the community and provided outstanding service to our region.

Senior Sports Award

Recognises the dedicated sports person coach, administrator, official or volunteer (over 26 years of age) whose actions inspire and encourage others to be part of a chosen sport.

Young Sports Award

Recognises the dedicated sports person coach, administrator, official or volunteer (aged 16-25) whose actions inspire and encourage others to be part of a chosen sport.
