

Red Cedar

Toona ciliata

TOON-ah sil-ee-Ah-tah



This large deciduous rainforest tree is well suited to large gardens as a feature or shade tree.

Mature trees have scaly, fissured bark and large buttresses. Growth habit depends greatly on environmental conditions. Plants grown in full sun will develop a spreading crown, while plants grown in sheltered forest situations will grow tall and straight.

Small, white, tubular flowers and green fruit which turn brown and open into a star shape and release seed.



Category: Large Tree (over 10m)

Height: up to 45 metres

Spread: 6-8 metres



Full sun to full shade



Prefers adequate moisture



Deep nutrient-rich well-drained soil
