



How to use our Mackay **Regional Council logos**



Above: Main logo in mono blue.

First preference: Full colour logo on a white background.

Types of logos

- Main logo is the first preference: Use with or without the Regional Device, vertically or horizontally
- Badge logo: Use when horizontal space is limited
- Long logo: Used for banners, screen presentations and signage
- URL logo: Used as a sign-off (eg on the back of a brochure)

Available colours of logos

- Full colour is the first preference/mono blue/mono green/mono black
- Never available in mono yellow
- In sponsorship or sub-branding situations, a reverse colour (white) logo may be placed on a solid colour background

Allowable backgrounds

- Full colour logos must be used on a white background
- Single colour logos (ie all red) must be used in order of preference: White background; solid colour background (only PMS approved colours), on a light coloured background
- Mono white logo must not be used on a light coloured background
- A yellow background is only for limited corporate use

Other rules

- All logos must be resized proportionally (never stretched)
- All logos must have sufficient white space around them so they stand out

Logo symbols should never appear without the words Mackay Regional Council

Mackay REGIONAL COUNCIL

- Never apply a drop shadow to the logo.
- Regional Device must only be used in conjunction with the main logo
- Minimum size to use logos: Main logo - 32mm > Badge logo
- 13mm > Long logo 28mm > URL logo - 28mm
