## Standard Drawings for Water, Sewerage and Sewage Pumping Stations

### 1 Purpose of this Information Bulletin

To advise that Council has amended the standard drawings for the design and construction of water, sewerage and sewage pumping stations and associated infrastructure to align with the *Planning Scheme Policy – Water & Sewerage CTM Water Alliance (CTM Code)*.

### 2 Details

Council's standard drawings have been amended to better respond to the CTM Code. Amendments include:

- 1) Integration of standard drawing and CTM Code Pages: The standard drawing page will now be linked to the CTM Code drawings page. This integration will provide a centralised location for all relevant drawings and guidelines. This will reduce confusion and ensure that the appropriate references are readily available.
- 2) Inclusion of CTM Code approved SEQ Drawings: The CTM Code page will now include the CTM Code Drawings, CTM Code approved SEQ drawings alongside the existing standard drawings which are not superseded by the SEQ drawings. This addition will help consultants and contractors easily access the required drawings for their projects.
- 3) SEQ Drawing Links: Due to copyright restrictions, Council is unable to directly link the SEQ drawings on Council's website. However, Council has provided a comprehensive table of approved SEQ drawings on the CTM Code page. Additionally, Council has included the necessary notes regarding changes that may be required in these drawings.
- 4) Availability of Superseded Standard Drawings: For developments approved prior to the implementation of the CTM Code, the superseded standard drawings will still be available for reference.

Council recommend that you familiarise yourself with these amendments in relation to current projects. These enhancements will benefit the industry by eliminating confusion and ensuring that the correct drawings are utilised in all developments. Council appreciates your cooperation and understanding throughout this process.
